We have been working on the outdoor environment in preparation for our Trip to Itchen Valley. We are trying to write at greater length in preparation for year 1; encouraging longer sentences and connecting words.

In maths we are developing our problem solving and working on recording simple calculations.

In reading we are looking at Information books and websites which help us find out about animals in our environment.

Our assessment and data has recently been moderated successfully by Hampshire County Council. This happens every four years in EYFS. The children have been very helpful in the selection process for new support staff for the early years. Some had to listen to two stories in one morning!

### Taking Family Holidays During Term Time - Important advice for Parents

We would like to draw your attention to the following important information relating to the changes that came into effect in September 2013 regarding taking children out of school during term time.

Children have 13 weeks annual holiday from school and school holiday dates are published well in advance online. As such, all parents/carers are expected to plan and take their family holidays at this time so as not to disrupt their children's education. The law states that parents **do not** have a right to take their child out of school for a holiday during term time. Only in exceptional circumstances may a headteacher grant permission for leave and it is the headteachers decision how many days to approve. Parents/carers who take their child out of school without written permission from the school can be issued with a fixed penalty fine.
