

Slithering Snake Surprise

This mouth-watering snack can feed three humans. It is filled with the most delicious taste that will bubble up your nose and burn through your throat. These simple ten steps are easy to follow to get your venom soup.

Ingredients

5 sharp snake fangs
120g of venom
10 rattlesnake tails
2 pairs of rats eyeballs
130g of snake spit

Equipment list

1 small bowl
1 metal spoon
1 glass
1 large metal pan
1 smooth spoon
1 china plate
1 large wooden bowl
1 small china plate

Method

1. Carefully, without hurting yourself, put the 5 snake fangs in a metal pan with some hot water.
2. Grab a wooden spoon and get 2 pairs of rats' eyeballs, then gently plop them into the metal pan.
3. Stir what you have got so far.
4. Get 1 small china plate and gently place the rattlesnake tails on it. Put them in the oven.
5. While the tails are baking get the snake spit and venom and pour it in a small bowl and mix it together with a metal spoon.
6. Now it is time to make the drink with the leftover spit and venom.
7. Get a glass and stir it with your finger.
8. Now get the pan with the snake fangs and rats eyeballs, pour the hot water away and put it on the plate.
9. While your drink and snack are waiting, take the tails out of the oven and put them with the rest.
10. Finally get the soup.

8. Following that cut a hole in the middle and sprinkle the snake shreadings and snake eyeballs inside the hole.
9. Cut the snake surprise biscuits into squares and you can share them with your friends and family (but don't forget to tell them what's in it).
