Year 3 trip to Pizza Express and Rock Up on Thursday 2nd March

As part of our Design Technology (DT) curriculum in Year 3, we are going to learn more about pizza in a mini project. We will be learning about the origins of pizza, how it is made, designing and making our own pizzas and creating packaging for them.

Pizza Express in Whiteley offer schools the chance to visit the restaurant, learn about food safety guidelines and make their own pizzas. We would like to take advantage of this great opportunity on Thursday 2nd March. We need to be at the restaurant to start our session at 9.30am.

If it is possible, I would like to meet the children outside Pizza Express in Whiteley at between 9.20 and 9.30am. If there are any problems getting the children to Whiteley at this slightly later time, please let us know and we may be able to organise alternative transport from school.

After the trip to Pizza Express, we have kindly been invited to have a free trial session at Rock Up. I thought it was easier to combine these two opportunities as they are so close to each other. We should be ready to leave the shopping centre at about 1pm and walk back to school for approx. 1.30pm.

The children will have had the opportunity to eat pizza for lunch but if there is any reason why your child may need an alternative lunch, please send them with a packed lunch on this day. Children will need to wear school jumpers but they will need to wear suitable trousers and shoes for rock climbing. They will also need a warm coat for the walk back to school.
