Dear Parents,

Narwhals' learning quest this term has a focus on polar explorers and we are hoping to bring this topic to life with a visit to Gilbert White's House & The Oates Collections on **Wednesday 16 October 2019**. The visit will offer a great opportunity for the children to discover why explorers travelled to Antarctica, what they took with them and what it was like to be there. They might even go on their own expedition during our visit.

Your child will need to wear comfortable trousers with their school polo shirt and sweatshirt. Trainers or similar comfortable shoes and a waterproof coat will also be needed.

For lunch, you can send your child with their own packed lunch. Alternatively, you can order a school packed lunch (chicken OR cheese roll) via Hampshire caterers free of charge. Please could you indicate your child's preferred option on the reply slip overleaf. Your child will need to bring a large water bottle (no cans please) in a named backpack.

To limit any chance of upset or things going missing, we will not be permitting children to take spending money on this trip. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.15am. We are planning to leave by coach at around 2.15pm, to be back in time for the end of the school day.

We are asking for a voluntary parental contribution of £18.80 to cover the cost of travel and the workshop. Without this support, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Payment should ideally be made via our online payment system, Scopay; please ask the school office if you need a reminder of your log-in details.

Please ensure that your completed consent form and your voluntary contribution are returned to the school by Tuesday 8 October at the latest, as the cook will need to order in any packed lunch items.
