Dear Parents,

As part of the Year 2 Curriculum, our next learning quest will be focused around the Titanic. To enhance the children's learning, we are taking them to Sea City Museum, in Southampton, on Tuesday 4th February 2020. The children will be doing a workshop and a facilitated discovery tour, as well as having some self-guided time in the museum.

Regular school uniform should be worn for the trip. Please remember that your child will need a waterproof coat, in case of inclement weather. Please bring a packed lunch in a named backpack and a large water bottle (no cans please). Alternatively, you can order a school packed lunch, free of charge, on the reply slip overleaf.

To limit any chance of upset or things going missing, we will not be permitting children to take spending money on this trip. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.15am. We will return in time for the end of the school day.

We are trying to reduce the amount of paper going out of/coming into the office. To this end, please tick the "consent" box in your child's Scopay account to give your consent for this trip, rather than returning a paper reply slip to us. Using this facility will enable you to pay online. We are asking for a voluntary parental contribution of £17.25 to cover the cost of travel and the admission charges. Without this support, the trip will not be able to go ahead.

If you do not wish to pay online, or you are ordering a school packed lunch, please return the slip overleaf to the school office with your cash or cheque payment. If you need a reminder of your Scopay login details, ask the school office.

Please ensure that we have your consent by Tuesday 28th January 2020.
