Y5 Fairthorne Manor Residential

Dear Parents,

I am writing to you to share details of your child's residential for next academic year. Our plan is to spend two nights at Fairthorne Manor from 16th-18th September 2020. The cost of the trip will be **£172 per child**. We will aim to pick both dry and water-based activities to challenge the children physically and promote teamwork, independence and confidence building. There will be 8 main activities and two evening activities. This residential will involve sleeping rooms as a group, which the children will be able to have some choice over. As part of the package, meals will be provided by the centre.

This term the current Year 5 class have undertaken this trip, and the feedback from both children and parents has been very positive. The vast majority of parents were able to drop their child off at the centre at 11am on the first morning and collect them at 1.30pm on the third day. This enabled us to keep costs down by not hiring a coach.

We would like to finalise numbers of pupils with the centre by January so would appreciate you returning the attached agreement and paying a non-refundable deposit of £30 by **Monday 16th December**.

We will be running an information evening for parents on **Monday 25th November** at 6pm. The residential information evening will probably only last 30-45 minutes, but will be an opportunity to share information about proposed activities, agreed accommodation and to share literature from the centre. To help spread the cost of the trip, the full cost has been added to your child's Scopay account. You can therefore make payments of your choice between now and the payment deadlines.
