Y6 Calshot Residential Trip 9 -12 June 2020

Dear Parents,

I would like to share details of your child's residential trip for the academic year 2019/20.

We will spend **three nights / four days** at Calshot Activity Centre. Calshot is a well-established centre and one that is fully approved by the Hampshire Outdoor Education Team. The cost of this residential will be **£365 per child**. This includes all activities, meals, accommodation, bedding and transport to and from the Centre.

We have discussed with the Centre the activities we would like to undertake, which include both land and sea-based activities to further challenge the children following on from their Fairthorne Manor experience. There will be 12 main activities and 3 evening activities. The activities the children will experience include:

Dingy sailing; sea kayaking; windsurfing; dry slope skiing; dry slope snowboarding and track cycling

This residential trip will involve sleeping in rooms as a group, which the children will again be able to have some choice over. We will be accommodated in a brick building with ample facilities and you can find out more about the Centre by visiting their website at:

We will also be holding an information evening for parents on Monday 13 January at 6.30pm

We will need a non-refundable deposit of £50 to confirm your child's place, payable by Friday 29 November. The balance of £315 must be paid by Thursday 30 April 2020. To help spread the cost of the trip, the full cost has been added to your child's Scopay account. You can therefore make payments of your choice between now and the payment deadlines.
