Dear Parents,

As part of our learning in the Spring term, we have booked a visit to the Weald & Downland Living Museum for Wednesday 15th January 2020. This is an all-day trip; the coach will leave school by 9:15am and return to school by home time.

We will be doing two Building Blocks workshops, learning how houses were built and how people lived in the past, which will support our work on the Great Fire of London,

We are grateful to the Cornerstone PTA, for contributing £2.50 per head towards the cost of the trip. We are asking for a voluntary parental contribution of £16.25 to cover the cost of travel, admission to the museum and the workshops. Without this support, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Payment should be made via our online payment system. Please do not hesitate to speak to your child's teacher, or the school office, if you have difficulties making this contribution or would prefer to stagger the payment.

We will need additional adult helpers for the trip. Please let us know if you can help and whether or not you have a DBS check in place.

Any inhalers and medication already held at school will be taken on the trip with us.
