Year 3 Trip: Fort Nelson

Dear Parents,

As part of our learning this term, Peacocks class are booked in for the *The Romans are Coming!* workshop at Fort Nelson Royal Armouries, near Portsmouth, on Friday 24th January 2020.

The children will be playing the roles of members of a Celtic tribe, deciding whether to help or hinder the Romans' failed invasion of 54-54 BC. They will also be learning about Iron Age food and customs and different roles in Roman Society as they decide if they want to remain Celts or switch allegiance to Rome.

For the trip, children should wear full school uniform and bring a waterproof coat.

Please send in a packed lunch (in a named bag) and a water bottle. You may order a school packed lunch for your child, at a cost of £2.40, on the reply slip overleaf. To limit any chance of upset or things going missing, we will not be permitting children to take spending money on this trip.

We will travel by coach, leaving at 9.00am and returning in time for the end of the school day.
