As part of the Year 5 science curriculum, our next learning quest will be focused on Space. To enhance the children's learning, we are taking them to Winchester Science Centre on Tuesday 14th January 2020.

The visit will offer a great opportunity for the children to learn about our solar system and how our understanding of it has changed over the years. They will be taking part in a workshop, exploring the hands-on exhibit and experiencing a Space Explorer presentation in the Planetarium.

Regular school uniform should be worn for the trip, and please remember to take a waterproof coat, in case of inclement weather.

Please bring a packed lunch (in a named bag or rucksack) and a water bottle. You may order a school packed lunch for your child, at a cost of £2.40, on the reply slip overleaf.
