Year 4 Swimming Lessons

Dear Parents,

As part of our PE curriculum, we will be running swimming lessons for our Year 4 pupils in the summer term. These will take place over 8 weeks, on Wednesdays, from 29 April to 24 June at Holly Hill Leisure Centre in Sarisbury Green.

A coach will take the children to the pool, and there will be 2 instructors to teach at different swimming ability levels for an hour-long session each week.

The cost of pool hire, swimming instructors and coach journeys obviously puts a considerable strain on our school budget, so the PTA have very kindly offered to support us with a donation of £20 per child. This is greatly appreciated.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £25.70 per child from our Year 4 parents, to cover the cost of the coach travel. This equates to £3.21 per week. Payment for the pool hire and instructors will come from the school budget.
